- The clubs will shortly enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) setting out the terms of the proposed amalgamation.
- 6. After the MOU is executed, the Club and Dubbo RSL will convene separate general meetings for the members of each club to vote on the proposed amalgamation.
- 7. A Notice of General Meeting will be sent to members of the Club so that it is received at least twenty (21) clear days before the General Meeting.
- 8. A copy of the Notice of General Meeting will also be displayed on the Club's noticeboard and on the Club's website.
- A copy of the MOU will be made available to members on the Club's noticeboard and website at least twenty-one (21) days before the abovementioned general meeting.
- 10. Apart from the expressions of interest referred to in paragraph 2 above, the Club also had informal discussions regarding an amalgamation with Bathurst RSL Club Limited (**Bathurst RSL**) during the past twelve (12) months. However, the Board decided against proceeding with an amalgamation with Bathurst RSL.
- 11. As required by clause 5 of the Registered Clubs Regulation 2015, this Notice will be displayed on the Club's noticeboard and website.
